

What Can You Do About Darfur and Sudan?

1. **Keep informed.**

2. **Join the SF Bay Area Darfur Coalition; send an email to info@darfursf.org.**

3. **Join Darfur Friday. Do you have 5 minutes per week for Darfur?**

Receive an email every week with a suggested action (sign an e-petition, call Congress, etc.) to take on Friday. Forward that email to others at your work, school, any organization. It only takes a couple of minutes once per week, but your participation will make a difference. Sign up at www.darfursf.org.

4. **Call 1-800-GENOCIDE.**

Program 1-800-GENOCIDE (1-800-436-6243) into your cell phone. Call it regularly to advocate for Sudan with the President, your Senators or your Congressperson. You choose who to call by entering your zip code and using the phone tree; Genocide Intervention Network gives you the script and connects you. It's simple; it works, and it counts!

5. **Help internationalize activism.**

Think about your contacts around the world. Get in touch with them. Ask what they are doing to end genocide in Darfur. Inform them. Motivate them to act. San Francisco Bay Area Darfur Coalition can help you with resources.
